From there we will travel around Firth Lake where we will cross the 736 foot long boardwalk, past 2 new DCAs, and finally out on the logging road to 250th Ave. This hike will be 5.9 miles. Save the document to your computer and then send it to NPS as an attachment. Or print off your completed document, sign it, and mail it to the NPS. The email address is on the directions page that comes with the form.
